

Background

- The world is moving fast towards energy-efficient lighting.
- The low-energy light bulbs and other efficient lighting systems could have an important impact on consumer energy bills, quality of supply and global warming.
- 2012 report by UNEP/GEF en.lighten initiative estimated that the transition to efficient lighting in sub-Saharan Africa would achieve significant economic and environmental impact:
 - 14 TWh of energy saved annually
 - Peak load shaving and reduction of power outages
 - 10.5M tons of CO₂ emissions avoided
